Earning a Letter

Students earn a letter by participating in athletics and/or by making the academic Honor Roll

Each patch may be earned once

Pins are cumulative



Varsity Letter

EARNED ONCE

This patch is earned the first time that a student completes a season at the varsity level

Pins represent specific sports, number of years, and special distinctions




Junior Varsity Letter

EARNED ONCE

This patch is earned the first time that a student completes a season at the junior varsity level

Pins are awarded for special distinctions only



Class Numerals

EARNED ONCE

Class numerals are earned the first time that a student completes a season as a freshman

There are variations of this tradition



Academic Letter

EARNED ONCE

This patch is earned the first time that a student makes the Honor Roll

Pins represent the number of semesters that the Honor Roll was earned

Gold = All As

Silver = All As and Bs



Special Patches

Special patches are awarded to students and coaches for conference titles, IHSA titles, and participation at State



Athletic Banners

ONE FOR EACH TEAM

Used for Homecoming and Awards Ceremonies

Championship titles are proudly displayed
